- Member* of a CityRise Campus for a minimum of 1 year; demonstrating active participation
- Previously accepted into an institution of higher learning
- Pursuing an <u>undergraduate degree</u>
- Average passing grade in current school year (if in college, $gpa \ge 2.5$)
- Contributes consistently to the life of the Church

Current scholarship funds are available through an endowment fund managed by the Baptist Foundation and an endowment managed by Houston Christian University. The amount depends on the available earnings in those funds at the time of disbursement.

TRUST REQUIREMENTS

The instructions from the fund donor are "to assist members of said Church with the costs of higher education."

The Trust Agreement governing the Scholarship Funds states the following:

"All grantees of scholarships must maintain an average passing grade, to be eligible for aid hereunder. A grantee who fails two subjects in one semester shall be ineligible for further aid until he brings his average up to passing. Any grantee dismissed from an institution for disciplinary reasons shall be ineligible for further aid."

"Grantee shall not engage in gambling, nor in drug abuse, nor be a frequent user of alcoholic beverages."

*BYLAWS ARTICLE 3 - MEMBERS

3.01. Qualification and Approval of Members.

- a. <u>Qualification</u>. Any person may offer himself or herself as a candidate for Membership in this Church. All such candidates shall be presented to the Church for Membership in any of the following ways:
 - i. By profession of faith and for baptism according to the policies of this Church.
 - ii. By promise of a letter of recommendation from another Baptist church or church of like faith.
 - iii. By statement of prior conversion experience and believers' baptism by immersion.
- b. <u>Approval.</u> An individual will become a Member after approval by a majority vote from the Executive Council.
